


Curtain Lok monitors both speed and acceleration. Curtain Lok will automatically lock a divider curtain in position at any time whether in storage or during the raising/lowering cycle should the movement exceed normal operating parameters. In the event of an over-speed situation caused by a malfunction of the hoisting apparatus the significant increase in cycle speed immediately activates the locking device. The locking mechanism reacts to the speed of the drive shaft and prevent it from exceeding a speed of approximately 200 RPM or about 1 foot per second.

The locking mechanism is fail-safe and never requires any type of lubrication.
The Curtain Lok unit incorporates a fully automatic reset and does not require poles, ropes, levers or buttons to reset.
The unit has a cast aluminum housing and all steel internal mechanism and mounting brackets.






### Curtain Lok Dimensions

#### The Curtain Lok is designed to stop a shaft from rotating in the event of a sudden unexpected increase in speed or a gradual over-speed.

#### **ANNUAL MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Test the unit annually with the curtain in the lowered position.
- 2. Remove only the two ½" bolts that secure the rotating portion of the unit to the pipe. The rotating portion of the unit should spin freely and should not be providing any support to the curtain shaft. Grasp the rotating portion of the unit and quickly turn in the down rotation to assure the unit locks. Once you have proven the unit locks, reverse the direction of rotation to free the locking mechanism and reattach to the pipe using the hardware as per installation instructions.

If the unit does not lock, contact your manufacturer and replace the unit.

#### Section 1 - Installation Instructions


- 1. Assure that the structure you are mounting the Curtain Lok to is sufficient to handle the shock load in the event of a shaft failure.
- 2. Curtain Lok should be attached as close to the motor unit as possible, but may be placed farther away from the motor unit if necessary.
- 3. Slide the unit on to the 2-3" (60mm) drive pipe. Make sure the DOWN arrow on the Curtain Lok hub will rotate in the proper direction when lowering the curtain. The unit will not function properly if the orientation is reversed.
- 4. Connect the Curtain Lok to the supporting structure.


Please Note: Be sure to align the unit such that it is not loaded by the rotating shaft.

The rotating hub of the Curtain Lok should spin freely and should not be providing any support to the rotating shaft.

- 5. Drill through the pipe using the Curtain Lock 1/2" (13mm) bushing holes as guide.
- 6. Insert the ½" (13mm) bolt through each side of the Curtain Lok and fasten to approximately 25 ft. lbs. torque using the ½" (13mm) Nyloc nuts. Check all connections.
- 7. Run the curtain or batting cage in both UP and DOWN to confirm the Curtain Lok is rotating freely.

Please Note: The Curtain Lock does not require any lubrication and should never be lubricated. Make sure all connections are secure, tightening as necessary.





Please Note: The unit only locks in one direction. The arrow on the hub of the Curtain Lock indicates the downward rotation of the device and should be tested prior to powering your equipment.
